Turn **right** onto **Medway Branch Road** for approximately **.2mile**;
Arrive at **33 Medway Branch Road**

The Transfer Station is on the right at the end of Medway Branch.

Waste Limit: You may bring no more than 25 pounds or ~~10~~(1 gallon) of listed hazardous waste materials to this event unless specifically approved by **Town of Norfolk's** Coordinator. Please see the back of this form for a list of acceptable household items, or call 508-528-4990.

- Large quantities of unknown materials
- Radioactive waste, including smoke detectors
- Explosives, gun powder, flares, ammunition
- Unsuitable waste
- Pressurized fire extinguishers
- Unknown gas cylinders
- Substances regulated by the Drug Enforcement Agency
- Medical Waste

Items accepted for an additional charge:

- **Propane tanks** \$ 5.00 each
- **Units with Freon** \$ 15.00 each
- **Microwave Ovens** \$ 5.00 each

- **E-Waste** \$.35 per pound
