Each application must include the following:

- A sketch of the lot showing existing lot line information, existing dwelling location, existing water service location, existing well location, existing on-site septic location, existing easements and existing parking areas. Sketch shall include detail (dimensions and location) of the proposed fowl or rabbit enclosure and shelter, animal food storage location and temporary waste storage area and/or composting area. Sketch must also include the location of private wells within 100 feet of the proposed fowl/rabbit enclosure or a note stating that there are no private wells within 100 feet of the animal enclosure.
- A certified abutter's list obtained from the Millis Assessors Office identifying each direct abutter to the property for which the application is being made
- Written notice stating the applicant's intent to raise or keep domesticated fowl or rabbits. Notice must include the number of fowl or rabbits.

I have read the regulations governing the raising of domesticated fowl or rabbits and I understand and agree to the requirements. I further understand that the Health Department may conduct periodic inspections of my facility.
