School Building Progress

We are progressing steadily and are at 70% completion of the building. The roof panels are complete with a few small details left to finish. The windows are also complete with one exception. We have left one window group at an entrance unfinished to bring equipment into the building through that access point. You will see photos of both the exterior and interior of the building in this edition.

Eversource has connected the permanent power and the water connection to the inside of the building has been completed. We anticipate the completion of the gas connection shortly. Once the gas connection is completed, we can begin testing the boilers and other systems. There will be heat in the building, from the boilers, late in March.

Interior work continues. 65-70 workers are on site daily with electrical, plumbing, HVAC, wiring, painting and tile trades. At the ESBC meeting on February 12th (video available on Facebook on the Millis Community Media site), furniture orders for student desks and chairs were approved for purchase. Technology needs have been identified and computer equipment will be approved for purchase at our next meeting on March 12th.

We are still on schedule and on budget. The MSBA has reimbursed the Town \$13,145,118 to date and we have an additional 2 Million reimbursement pending this month.
