School Building Progress

We are seeing significant progress both on the exterior and the interior of the building. You will see photos of both the exterior and interior of the building in this edition.

The Standing Seam Metal Roof work continues and we expect the majority of the roof work to be finished in the next two weeks. There will be a few small areas still to be completed over the next month. The weather has allowed us to complete some other outside work including windows and a retaining wall. Skylights have been installed. The majority of the schedule slippage has been made up and we are once again on schedule. Permanent power (electricity) is scheduled to be connected on January 25, depending on Eversource. The gas connection has been made and will need to be hooked up when the boilers and hot water heaters are fully hooked-up with water. That work is scheduled to be completed by the third week of February. Work continues on the Gym and Cafeteria windows and interiors.

Interior work involves painting, casework installation, ceiling tile and other finishes in C wing. D wing is progressing with mechanicals installation and drywall. 65-70 workers are on site daily with electrical, plumbing, HVAC, wiring, and tile trades. Cafeteria kitchen equipment is being installed. Freezers and coolers have been installed. At the ESBC meeting on January 16 (video available on Facebook on the Millis Community Media site), preliminary decisions were reviewed for the purchase of student desks and chairs, teacher and administrator equipment. Technology needs have been identified and computer equipment will be purchased in the Spring.

We are on schedule and on budget. The project is about 60% complete. The MSBA has reimbursed the Town \$13,145,118 to date.
